The bridge deck is 1.60 meters wide, made of sturdy metal grating, with handrails and wire mesh for safety . These bridges typically span 100 to 200 meters per main span, using high-tensile steel cables and wire mesh or wooden planks for the deck, primarily supporting pedestrian and light cargo traffic .
