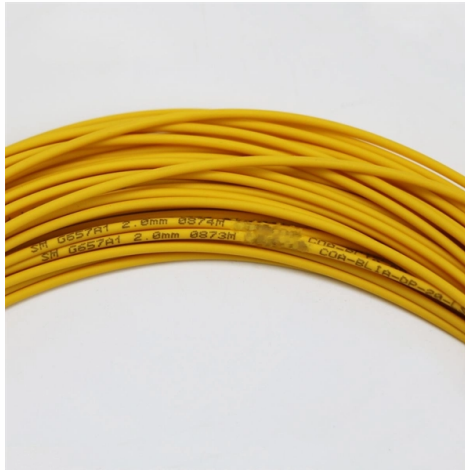


Neutral protection line of distribution box

Neutral bars and earth bars must be arranged according to the protection scheme; mixed neutrals downstream of RCDs are a common fault source. SPDs should be placed and wired to minimize lead length and coordinate with the earthing system. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices.
