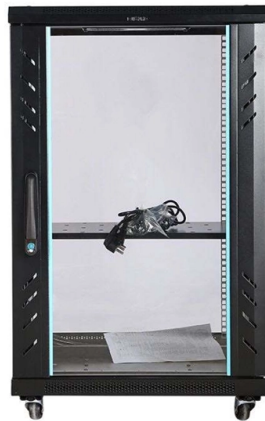


Now setting up the fiber optic router



AI Overview

To set up a fiber optic router, connect it to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), configure the router via its admin panel, and secure your Wi-Fi network for optimal performance.

Step 1: Gather Equipment Before starting, ensure you have: Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, Fiber optic cable (usually yellow with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors), Router compatible with fiber input (look for WAN or SFP ports), Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to the router, Power adapters for both the ONT and router.

Step 2: Connect the ONT Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP fiber line enters your home. Plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT's designated port. Power on the ONT and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize.

Step 3: Connect the Router Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the WAN port on your router. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 4: Access Router Settings On a computer or mobile device, connect via Ethernet or Wi-Fi. Open a web browser and enter the router's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1) or use the router's mobile app. Log in using the default credentials provided with the router.

Step 5: Configure Internet Connection Dynamic/Automatic IP: Use if your ISP does not require credentials. PPPoE: Enter the username and password provided by your ISP. Static IP: Enter the fixed IP address if assigned. L2TP/PPTP: Use if connecting through a VPN.

Step 6: Secure and Optimize Your Network Change the router admin password to prevent unauthorized access. Set a strong Wi-Fi password and choose WPA3 or WPA2 security. Update firmware on both the router and ONT for performance and security improvements. Position the router centrally in your home for optimal Wi-Fi coverage. Consider using CAT6 or better Ethernet cables for wired connections to critical devices.

Step 7: Test and Monitor Check internet speed and connectivity on multiple devices. Adjust router settings if needed for QoS, guest networks, or device...
