Third level distribution box: refers to the final junction box of each electrical appliance, which can be movable and fixed. Electrical equipment is installed under the switch box, forming a three-level distribution. In. From the transformer's low-voltage side (0. These boxes feature bottom entry and exit cables, front-opening doors, and main busbars connected with copper strips for optimal contact. Note: The three-level power distribution is mainly to ensure that each power-consuming device has electricity available; each power-consuming device can be used.
