It acts as a “translator,” converting electrical signals from the device into optical signals for transmission over fiber, or back into electrical signals for reception. SFP modules are hot-swappable, allowing replacement or upgrades without powering down the network device. Types and Speeds SFP: Supports 1–4 Gbps, commonly used for Gigabit Ethernet and Fibre Channel. SFP+: Supports up to 10 Gbps, suitable for high-speed data center links. SFP28: Supports 25 Gbps, designed for modern enterprise and carrier networks. SFP112: Emerging standard for low-power, high-efficiency applications in green data centers. Modules can support single-mode (SMF) or multi-mode fiber (MMF), with transmission distances ranging from 30 meters to 160 kilometers depending on the module and fiber type. Internal Structure The core components of an SFP module include: TOSA (Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts electrical signals into optical signals using a laser. ROSA (Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals; high-sensitivity modules may use APD receivers. Laser driver and limiting amplifier: Support multiple data rates and ensure signal integrity. Central controller: Manages module operation and diagnostics. Gold finger connector pins: Designed with varying lengths to ensure proper power-up sequencing. Optical components account for the majority of the module's cost and are critical for performance, especially in high-speed applications. Standards and Compatibility SFP modules adhere to Multi-Source Agreements (MSA), which define mechanical dimensions, pinouts, and electrical interfaces. This ensures physical int...
