The incoming line is often a medium-voltage feeder (5–35 kV in many systems) that has been stepped down by a distribution transformer to a safe utilization voltage, such as 120/240 V for residential or 220/415 V for industrial use . This main supply line enters the distribution box and connects to the main bus bar, which acts as the central hub for power distribution . Circuit Breakers or Fuses: Protective devices that prevent overloads and short circuits by interrupting the flow of electricity when necessary . Internal Wiring: Connects the bus bars to individual branch circuits, ensuring organized and safe distribution to different areas or devices . Branch Circuits From the bus bars, branch circuits carry electricity to specific loads, such as lighting, appliances, or industrial equipment. These circuits can be single-phase or three-phase, depending on the application, and are protected by individual breakers or fuses . In larger systems, laterals or secondary feeders may extend from the main trunk to cover the service area, often passing through additional transfor...
