For cabinets, nozzle or bar-type ionizers can target small cavities and narrow surfaces, neutralizing static on equipment and cables without introducing voltage fluctuations. Pulsed DC ionizers are particularly effective for high-speed or high-charge environments, as they maintain ion output over longer distances and prevent rebonding of ions.

Environmental Control Static buildup is exacerbated by low humidity (below 40%) and synthetic materials. Maintaining relative humidity between 40–60% reduces charge accumulation. Avoid insulating materials inside the cabinet, such as plastic trays or non-conductive cable ties, or replace them with dissipative alternatives.

Best Practices Position ionizers close to the target: Static neutralization is most effective when the charged object is in free air and not in contact with other surfaces. Double-sided neutralization: For thicker cables or multi-layered components, ensure ionization reaches all surfaces. Immediate dust removal: Statically attracted dust sh...
