- Polyvinyl chloride (PVC) – used in some applications for cost-effectiveness

These insulation types ensure safety, prevent leakage, and allow the cable to withstand environmental stresses.

Common Cable Standards

For medium-voltage primary distribution, the most widely used cables include:

- 15kV medium-voltage cables – standard for utility primary underground distribution, often with concentric neutral construction for grounding and fault protection
- XHHW-2 – used for feeder circuits and service entrance conductors, resistant to heat and abrasion
- THHN/THWN-2 – general-purpose building wire suitable for commercial and industrial panels
- Tray Cable (TC, TC-ER) – used in ducts, conduits, and cable trays for complex industrial panels
