Operational Standards Distribution boxes must maintain load balance, voltage stability, and power factor within acceptable limits. Regular inspection and maintenance schedules are required to ensure reliability and prevent outages. Any modifications or connections must be approved by the licensed utility to prevent illegal or unsafe connections.

Documentation and Compliance Installation must be accompanied by a signed Installation Completion Certificate (ICC) or equivalent, confirming compliance with technical standards. Operators should maintain records...
