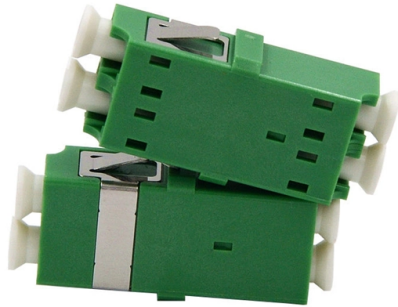


Replace the free fiber optic router
