- Enclosure and IP rating:** Boxes must be robust and weather-resistant, typically IP44 to IP67, depending on exposure.
- Material and impact resistance:** Enclosures are made from thermoplastic or sheet steel with high IK impact ratings (IK08–IK10) to withstand site conditions.
- Socket and circuit protection:** Equipped with MCBs, fuses, and RCDs (residual current devices) to protect circuits, with RCDs rated for ≤ 500 mA for circuits ≤ 32 A.
- Emergency stop and safety features:** Many Level 2 boxes include emergency push buttons, interlocked sockets, and strain-resistant cable hooks to prevent accidental disconnection or overload.
- Modularity:** Configurations can include multiple socket types, switch panels, and busbar arrangements to suit site-specific needs.
