

Requirements for protective openings of distribution boxes



Overview

Conductors must enter through approved openings and be protected from abrasion. Requirements include: Boxes must be equipped with covers unless they contain a device or luminaire canopy. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures. Article 314 applies to: These. A safe enclosure isn't just about housing components—it requires proper materials, climate control, secure locks, and compliance with industry standards. Site selection requirements: The distribution box should be installed in an area close to the power supply to reduce. Precisely mitered and assembled aluminum frames screw mounted to rough opening frame. Comply with USPS requirements that distance from center line of master lock in top tier of boxes not exceed 58" above the finished floor.

Mailbox units and accessories shall be installed in accurately framed openings with units plumb and firmly secured in position. Install mailboxes in accordance with shop drawings and manufacturer's

eCFR :: 29 CFR 1910.303 -

(i) Unused openings in boxes, raceways, auxiliary gutters, cabinets, equipment cases, or housings shall be effectively closed to afford protection substantially equivalent to the wall of the equipment.
