- Use Proper Testing Equipment** Since single-mode light is invisible, use an optical power meter or fiber tester to verify signal output. A loopback test can also help confirm the module is operational.
- Check Port and Module Status** Ensure the switch port is enabled and configured correctly. Some switches require manual activation of optical ports or specific speed/duplex settings. If the module or port is defective, swapping with a known working module or port can help isolate the issue.
- Inspect Fiber for Damage** Faulty splices, bends, or breaks in the fiber can prevent light from reaching the other end. Testing with a different fiber or checking continuity can identify such problems.
