Distribution Box Overview A distribution box (or distribution board) is the central point where electrical power is distributed to multiple circuits in a building. It contains essential components such as the main breaker, busbars, neutral bars, earth/ground bars, and branch circuit breakers. The main breaker controls the overall power supply, while branch breakers protect individual circuits, including lighting, sockets, and appliances.

Ground Wire Function The ground wire (protective earth, PE) is crucial for safety. It provides a low-resistance path for fault currents to flow safely into the earth, preventing electric shock and equipment damage. In a distribution box, the ground wire is connected to the earth bar, which may also be linked to the metal enclosure of the box for additional protection. The resistance between all grounded components should be very low, typically below 0.1 Ohm, to ensure effective fault current dissipation.

Socket Wiring Modern sockets have three terminals:

- Phase (L):** Supplies live current, usually brown or black insulation.
- Neutral (N):** Returns current, usually blue insulation.
- Protective Earth (PE):** Connects to the ground pin, usually yellow-green insulation.

For safety, sockets must be connected to the PE wire. In older installations without grounding, only double-insulated appliances can be safely used, but modern standards require grounding for all new or upgraded sockets. E-type sockets, with a central grounding pin, are mandatory in many countries for rooms with high humidity or for class I equipment like washing machines and refrigerators.

Installation Tips Always ensure the ground wire is continuous from the distribution box to the socket. Use proper connectors for grounding inside metal boxes, such as twist-on or crimp connectors. Verify that the ground resistance is within safe limits. If the PE wire is missing, the installation must...
