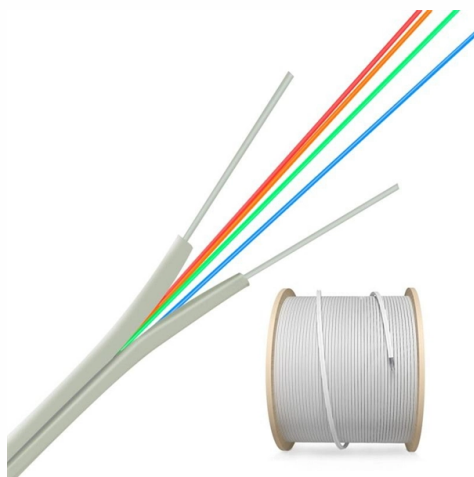

Cable Types and Applications

Fiber and Conductor Specifications

Fiber Types: Commonly ITU-T G.652D single-mode fibers for long-distance and high-speed communication. Multimode fibers may also be used for short-range applications (TSAC, IMDA).

Conductor Materials: Pure copper is preferred for electrical conductors in hybrid cables, offering superior conductivity and compliance with safety standards. Copper-clad aluminum (CCA) may be used in cost-sensitive applications but has lower performance and regulatory limitations (Alibaba seller guide).

Fiber Count: Varies by cable type; OPGW cables can support up to 96 fibers in double-layer designs, while indoor/outdoor cables may range from 2 to 144 fibers depending on application den...
