Typical spacing depends on tray type, material, and load but often ranges from 1.5 m to 3 m for standard industrial installations. Mounting: Supports can be wall-mounted, floor-to-ceiling, or attached to structural steel. Adjustable brackets allow for alignment and leveling of the tray. Fittings: Vertical supports may include bends, T-pieces, or crossovers to accommodate changes in tray direction or height. Standards and Compliance IEC 61537: Specifies construction, testing, and performance requirements.
