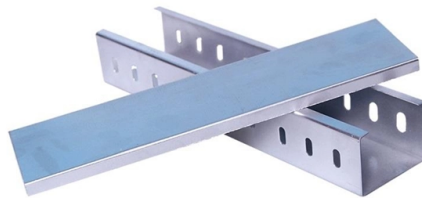


Standard Configuration of On-site Distribution Box

- Optional Smart Modules:** Energy monitoring units or communication modules for real-time data and remote control.

Enclosure and Material

- Material:** Steel for industrial durability or polycarbonate/ASA plastics for indoor or corrosive environments.
- Ingress Protection (IP) Rating:** IP20 for dry indoor areas, IP65 for dusty or wet environments.
- Height and Placement:** Typically installed at ~1.5 meters in dry, ventilated, and accessible locations.
- Electrical Standards and Safety Compliance:** With NEC, IEC, or local codes is essential.
- Proper grounding and earthing** to protect against electrical faults.
- Use of UL/CE-certified components** for reliability.
- Voltage and current ratings** must match the expected load to prevent ov...
