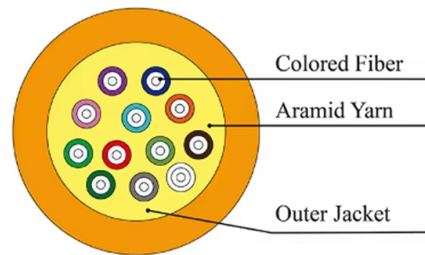

Practical Notes Covers should allow for heat dissipation and cable expansion, so trays are typically filled to 40% capacity Weight calculations are essential for support spacing; closer hangers are required for heavier covers or long spans Perforated covers reduce weight by 10–35% depending on the open area pattern By selecting the correct cover size and material, and calculating the weight accurately, you ensure structural integrity, safety, and compliance with electrical and mechanical standards.
