NEC standards specify a maximum mounting height of 2 meters and require readily accessible locations with sufficient working space in front of the panel (minimum 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high). Clearance and Working Space Adequate working space around the distribution box is essential for safety and maintenance. Standards such as BS 7671 and NEC 110.26 require clearances to allow full access to the panel, including the ability to open doors to 90° without obstruction. Industrial boards with IP54 protection typically require a mounting area up to 1.5 meters wide, 1.2 meters high, and 0.5 meters deep. Fixing and Stability Distribution boxes should be firmly fixed using suitable brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibrat...
