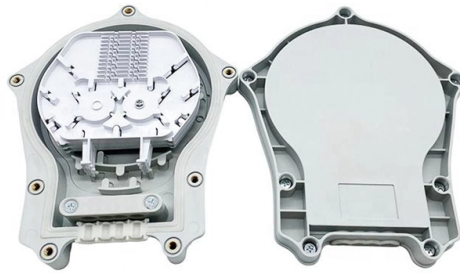


Steps for installing cable trays side by side
