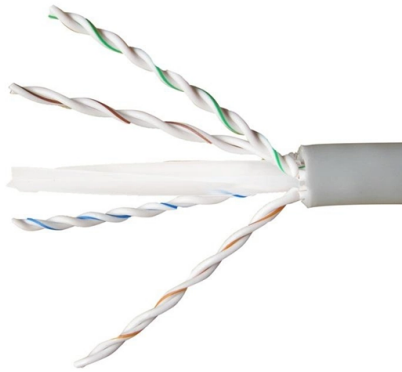

- Physical Security**
 - Place switches in locked cabinets or secure rooms to prevent unauthorized physical access.
 - Disable unused ports and enable port security to prevent rogue devices from connecting.
- Network Segmentation and VLANs**
 - Use VLANs to separate traffic types (e.g., management, user, and server traffic) to reduce the attack surface.
 - Avoid using default VLANs (like VLAN 1) for management traffic, as they are common targets for attackers.
- Port Security**
 - Limit the number of MAC addresses per port and define actions for violations, such as restricting traffic or generating alerts. This mitigates attacks like MAC address flooding and unauthorized device connections.
- Monitoring and Access Control**
 - Implement Network Access Control (NAC) to monitor devices attempting to connect and ensure they meet security policies.
 - Use Access Control Lists (ACLs) to filter inbound and outbound traffic, allowing only authorized IP addresses and protocols.
- Software Updates and Patch Management**
 - Regularly update switch firmware to address known vulnerabilities.
