Cost Components

Tariff costs typically include several elements:

- Power-based charges:** Applied per unit of capacity (EUR/MW), covering the ability to use the network at a given demand level.
- Lump-sum or fixed charges:** Monthly or annual fees for access to the network infrastructure, independent of usage.
- Levies and surcharges:** Additional costs may include offshore grid levies, concession fees, or subsidies adjustments, depending on national regulations.

For electricity networks, revenue caps are often applied to network operators to limit total recoverable costs, with adjustments made annually to reflect updated cost structures. Similar principles apply in telecommunications, where access to high-capacity switches is priced to recover operator costs while remaining competitive.

Tariff Calculation Methodology

Forward-looking cost models are commonly used to anticipate costs for the next regulatory period. These models consider expected volumes, operational costs, and investment requirements, ensuring that tariffs cover both fixed and variable costs. Incremental unit pricing may be applied, where the cost per unit of network usage differs by user group or voltage level, and residual costs are allocated...
