

Telecom splitter connects 4 households



AI Overview

A single fiber optic splitter can efficiently connect four households by dividing one incoming optical signal into four outputs, each serving a separate home.

How It Works A fiber optic splitter is a passive device that splits an incoming optical signal from the telecom provider into multiple outputs without requiring power. In a typical FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) network, the splitter sits between the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the central office and the Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at each household. For four households, a 1:4 splitter is used, meaning one input fiber is divided into four output fibers, each carrying the optical signal to a separate home.

Splitter Types

- PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) Splitter:** Uses silica glass waveguides to evenly distribute light across all outputs. It provides consistent signal strength and is ideal for uniform splits like 1:4.
- FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) Splitter:** Involves fusing two fibers together and pulling them to form a tapered shape. The split ratio depends on the fusion process and is suitable for small splits such as 1:2 or 1:4.

Deployment Considerations

- Bandwidth Sharing:** The total bandwidth from the OLT is shared among the four households. In a PON setup, downstream data is broadcast to all outputs, while upstream data uses time-division multiplexing (TDMA) to avoid collisions.
- Location:** Splitters can be installed in a central office, street cabinet, or near the homes. For small clusters, placing a 1:4 splitter close to the homes reduces fiber usage and simplifies connections.
- Scalability:** If more households are added later, splitters can be cascaded (e.g., 1:2 followed by another 1:2) to maintain efficient distribution without replacing the entire fiber infrastructure.

- Cost Efficiency:** One fiber serves multiple homes, reducing the need for separate fibers to each residence.
- Passive Operation:** No electricity is required, lowering maintenance and operational costs.
