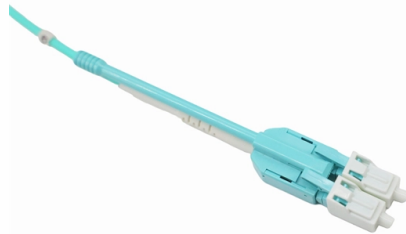


Temporary distribution box wiring



AI Overview

A temporary distribution box should be wired with a main power inlet feeding bus bars, branch circuit breakers, properly sized conductors, and secure grounding with GFCI protection for safety.

Main Components and Connections

Enclosure and Inlet: Use a NEMA-rated enclosure suitable for the environment (e.g., NEMA 3R for outdoor use). The main power inlet typically uses a heavy-duty twist-lock receptacle (30A or 50A) to connect to the power source ().

Bus Bars and Main Lugs: Inside the box, connect the incoming hot wires (black/red for 240V) to the hot bus bars, the neutral wire (white) to the neutral bus bar, and the ground wire (green or bare copper) to the ground bus bar. In a feeder panel, neutral and ground bars must remain separate, bonding only at the power source ().

Circuit Breakers: Install branch circuit breakers to protect each circuit. Single-pole breakers interrupt only the hot conductor, while double-pole breakers disconnect both hot and neutral for higher safety. The breaker rating must match the wire ampacity to prevent overheating ().

Branch Circuit Wiring: Run conductors from the load side of each breaker to the receptacles. Connect the hot wire to the breaker, the neutral to the neutral bus bar, and the ground to the ground bus bar. For GFCI receptacles, connect incoming hot and neutral to the terminals marked "LINE" and the ground to the green screw ().

Wire Sizing

Main feeder wires should match the inlet rating (e.g., 6 AWG copper for a 50A inlet). **Branch circuits** should match breaker ratings (e.g., 12 AWG for 20A circuits) ().

Grounding and Bonding

Grounding: Connect the ground bus bar to a dedicated grounding electrode system to stabilize voltage.

Bonding: Connect all non-current-carrying metal parts, including the enclosure, to the equipment grounding conductor to ensure a low-impedance path for fault currents ().

GFCI Protection

Required for all 125V, single-phase, 15-, 20-, and 30A receptacles used by personnel. GFCI devices monitor current balance and trip if leakage exceeds ~5 mA, preventing electric shock ().
