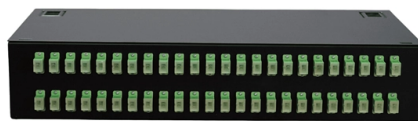


Terminal Distribution Box Wiring Connections

Wire Stripping and Crimping: Strip insulation to the correct length and crimp or screw wires securely into terminals to ensure good conductivity.

Neat Arrangement: Arrange wires neatly, use zip ties, and avoid contact with sharp edges. Leave space for heat dissipation.

Protective Devices: Install MCBs, RCCBs, and fuses according to load requirements. Ensure ratings match the circuit specifications.

Earthing: Connect the metallic body of the distribution box and all earth wires to the earth link to prevent electric shock.

Testing and Verification

Insulation Resistance Test: Use an insulation tester to check resistance between wires and the box; it should meet safety standards.

Circuit Continuity Test: Use a multimeter to verify that all circuits are correctly connected and there are no short circuits or broken wires.

Component Check: Confirm that all breakers, fuses, and protective devices operate normally.
