

The distance between the three-level distribution box and the electrical equipment

- Side Clearance:** Minimum of 30 inches (≈ 0.76 meters) from the sides of equipment, or at least the width of the equipment itself, to provide unobstructed access.
- Height Clearance:** Minimum headroom of 6.5 feet (≈ 2 meters) in front of the equipment, or the height of the equipment if taller, ensuring safe movement and tool operation.
- Dedicated Space:** Space extending from the floor to 6 feet above the equipment or structural ceiling must remain clear to allow safe operation and inspection.
- Environmental and Operational Considerations:** Install distribution boxes and switch boxes in dry, well-ventilated locations away from harmful gases, moisture, or mech...
