

Types of Cable Management Racks

They distribute cables between rack units, prevent sagging, reduce strain on terminations, and separate copper and fiber links. These managers are essential in environments with multiple devices and high cable volumes.
- 3. Brush Panels** Brush panels are used at cable entry and exit points to maintain a clean layout and reduce dust intrusion. The bristles allow cables to pass through while providing strain relief and protecting connections. They are particularly useful for managing cables across different U-levels in a rack.
- 4. Finger Ducts** Finger-duct designs feature slotted channels that allow precise routing of individual cable groups. Technicians can guide bundles into specific openings, improving organization in dense switch cabinets. Finger ducts help maintain bend-radius compliance and reduce cable congestion.
- 5. Ring and Cover-Type Managers** Ring-type cable managers use circular or semi-circular structures to route cables neatly along the path of the ring, allowing easy insertion and removal without disassembly. Cover-type managers consist of horizontal slots with a detachable or openable cover, protecting cables from dust, dirt, and external damage while keeping them hidden and organized.
