- Indoor Boxes: Used in protected environments like homes, offices, or utility rooms, typically with lower IP ratings.
- Outdoor Boxes: Designed for exposure to rain, dust, and temperature variations, requiring robust enclosures and higher IP protection.
- Metal Boxes: Common in industrial and commercial applications for mechanical strength and durability.
- Explosion-Proof or ATEX-Certified Boxes: Used in hazardous areas, made from stainless steel (AISI 304L or 316L) or GRP, capable of withstanding extreme temperatures and environmental conditions.
