Wall-mounted fiber optic cables are composed of ultra-pure silica cores, protective cladding, polymer coatings, strength members, and an outer jacket tailored for indoor installation.

Core and CladdingThe core is the central part of the fiber that transmits light signals and is typically made from ultra-pure silica glass (SiO_2), sometimes doped with germanium or phosphorus to control the refractive index for efficient light propagation. Surrounding the core is the cladding, also made of silica or specialized plastic, which reflects light back into the core to maintain signal integrity. For shorter or specialized runs, plastic optical fibers (POF) may be used instead of glass.

Coatings and Buffer LayersTo protect the delicate glass core, fiber optic cables include dual-layer UV-cured acrylate coatings: a soft primary coating and a hard secondary coating. These coatings prevent scratches, microbends, and mechanical damage. Additional buffer layers or tubes made from durable polymers provide flexibility and mechanical protection, especially important for wall-mounted installations.

Strength MembersWall-mounted cables often include aramid yarn (e.g., Kevlar®) as strength members, which provide tensile strength without conducting electricity. In some designs, fiberglass rods or steel wires may be added for extra reinforcement, though indoor cables typically rely on lightweight aramid fibers to maintain flexibility and ease of installation.

Outer JacketThe outer jacket protects the cable from environmental factors such as abrasion, moisture, and fire hazards. For indoor wall-mounted cables, jackets are usually made from PVC, low-smoke zero-halogen (LSZH), or flame-retardant polymers to comply with building codes and fire safety standards. The jacket type is selected based on the installation environment, ensuring durability and safety.
