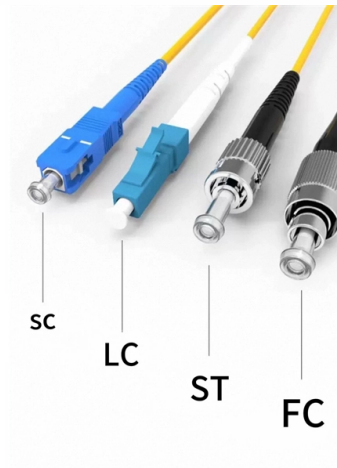


Weight of engineering cable trays



Overview

Developed sheet width per meter: $Dev = W + 2H + 2R$
