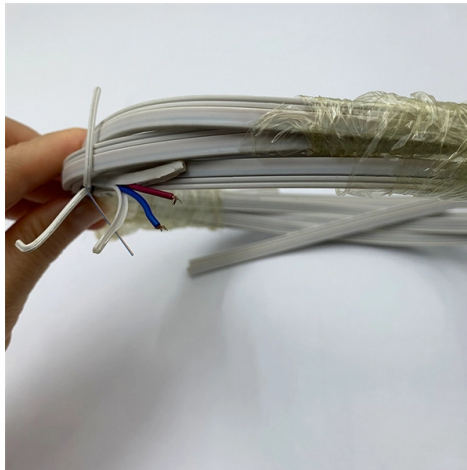


What are home server rack network devices

Essential Network Devices

- Router:** The router is the foundation of your home network, managing inbound and outbound traffic and providing a secure gateway to the internet. For home racks, consider routers with gigabit Ethernet ports, dual-band support, and advanced security features. Rack-mountable routers help centralize your network and reduce cable clutter.
- Switch:** Switches expand the number of Ethernet connections in your network. Managed switches allow control over VLANs, QoS, and traffic monitoring, while PoE switches can power devices like IP cameras and access points directly through Ethernet cables.
- Access Point (AP):** APs extend Wi-Fi coverage and eliminate dead zones. Look for APs supporting 802.11ac or 802.11ax (Wi-Fi 6) for faster, more reliable wireless connections. Rack-mounted APs or those connected via PoE simplify integration into your server rack.
- Modem:** A modem connects your home network to your ISP. For fiber or cable connections, ensure the modem is compatible with your ISP and supports high-speed data transfer. Some setups place the modem directly in the rack for easy access and cable management.

Additional Rack Network Components

- Patch Panel:** Organizes Ethernet runs and protects switch ports from frequent plugging/unplugging. It simplifies future cable changes and keeps the rack tidy.
- Rack-Mount Shelves:** For devices without rack ears, shelves or sliding trays can hold modems, small switches, or tools, maintaining airflow and accessibility.
- Power Management:** A PDU (Power Distribution Unit) or UPS ensures stable power delivery and protects devices during outages. Metered or switched PDUs allow monitoring of power usage for each device.
