Devices used in each layer of TCP/IP model

A router is a switch like device that routes/forwards data packets based on their IP addresses. Routers normally connect Local Area Network (LANs) and Wide Area Network (WANs)

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They connect directly to end devices such as computers, printers, phones, and wireless access points. Their main job is to provide connectivity and enforce basic network policies like VLAN assignments
