Monitoring and Control: Distributed control systems manage power, cooling, and environmental conditions. Smart racks and integrated sensors provide real-time data for operational efficiency and predictive maintenance.

Factory Prefabrication: Modules are pre-engineered, assembled, and tested in a controlled factory environment. This approach reduces onsite construction time, improves quality, and allows for standardized interfaces and rapid deployment.

Scalability and Flexibility: Micro-modular units can be deployed individually or in clusters, allowing phased expansion as IT demand grows. They are suitable for constrained spaces, edge loca...
