Cladding: Surrounds the core and reflects light back into it, usually made of fluoride-doped silica or similar materials. Buffer/Outer Jacket: A protective plastic coating, often acrylate or polyimide, that shields the fiber from physical damage and environmental factors. Glass fibers are preferred for long-distance, high-speed transmission due to lower signal loss, while plastic fibers are more flexible and easier to handle but less suitable for long distances.
