- Insert the fiber into the mechanical splice mechanism.
- Align the fiber in the V-groove and secure it with the clamping element.
- Remove the wedge clip to lock the fiber in place.
- Attach the connector housing to complete the termination.

The entire process typically takes about 2 minutes, making it highly efficient for field use.
