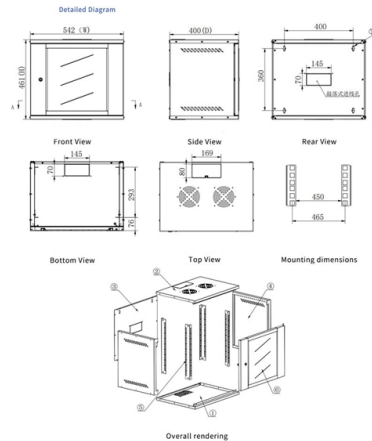

The longest international optical fiber cable is the SEA-ME-WE3, measuring 39,000 kilometers (39,000,000 meters). The SEA-ME-WE3 (South-East Asia – Middle East – Western Europe 3) cable is a submarine fiber-optic telecommunications system that connects Southeast Asia, the Middle East, Western Europe, and extends to Australia and Japan, making it the longest in the world . The SEA-ME-WE3 cable plays a critical role in global internet infrastructure, enabling high-speed data transmission, international communications, and supporting commerce and information exchange across billions of users . Its length of 39,000,000 meters makes it nearly equivalent to the circumference of the Earth, highlighting its significance as a major digital artery in the global telecommunications network.
