Installation and Fastening Channel nuts (M12 recommended for maximum load) are used with the channels for secure mounting. Hex bolts (M10 or M12) are typically used to attach channels to concrete or steel support frames. Channels can be mounted back-to-back for additional strength in heavy-duty applications. Summary For most industrial and commercial cable tray installations, 41 mm deep, 41 mm wide pre-galvanized or stainless steel channels are standard.
