

Where are the hidden locations of fiber optic cables in data centers

This keeps the cables out of the way of daily operations and allows for long-distance connections between different sections of the data center. Overhead routing is particularly common for cross-connects and inter-building links.

Vertical and Horizontal Cable Managers Within racks, fiber cables are often hidden inside vertical cable managers (4", 6", or 12" wide) and horizontal finger-style managers. These enclosures guide patch cords and trunk cables neatly, preventing excessive bending or stress that could degrade signal quality. Core cabinets and main patch panels typically have dense fiber routing hidden behind panels.

Trunking Assemblies Trunking locations are pre-planned pathways that carry multiple fiber strands as a single assembly. These trunks are often custom-built and routed under the floor or overhead, connecting major switches, storage arrays, and patch panels. Trunking ensures that high-density fiber connections remain organized and protected, while minimizing future errors during maintenance or upgrades.
