Large-scale deployments of 400G/800G optics, fiber-to-the-room (FTTR), and 5G-Advanced networks are consuming massive volumes of fiber, particularly high fiber-count cables.
- 4. Structural Market Shifts** Unlike previous cyclical price fluctuations, the current increase is structural. Demand for ultra-low-loss and bend-insensitive fibers (G.652D, G.657A1/A2) has surged, and global infrastructure investments, especially in AI and broadband, are sustaining high consumption levels. Chinese fiber prices have even surpassed European levels for the first time in over seven years, reflecting tight upstream supply and strong export flows to North America.
