Definition and Function A fiber optic patch cord is a short, flexible fiber optic cable with connectors on both ends, designed to connect optical devices such as transceivers, switches, routers, or patch panels . The connectors allow for rapid, plug-and-play connections, making it easy to reconfigure or troubleshoot networks without disturbing permanent splices . Patch cords are sometimes called fiber jumpers because they “jump” signals from one port to another.

Why the Term “Patch” Is Used The term “patch” comes from traditional telecommunication and electrical wiring, where a patch panel is used to interconnect circuits temporarily or flexibly. Similarly, a fiber optic patch cord provides a reconfigurable link between devices, enabling network changes, additions, or maintenance without altering the permanent fiber infrastructure . Unlike pigtailed, which are permanently spliced to fibers inside an optical distribution frame (ODF), patch cords are meant for front-end, flexible connections that can be moved, added, or changed quickly .
